**Road closures and increased traffic through
Golden Gate Park on Sunday, September 29 [2013]**

In honor of the Steinhart Aquarium's 90th anniversary, the California Academy of Sciences will offer free admission to visitors on Sunday, September 29 as a thank you to the City of San Francisco. On this same day, Alice Radio 97.3 will host the annual Now & Zen Fest concert at Sharon Meadow in Golden Gate Park, also free to the public. Regular Sunday street closures in Golden Gate Park will take place.

Traffic closures will be in effect as follows:

Major streets at the East end of Golden Gate Park—including a portion of John F. Kennedy Drive and Bowling Green Drive—will be **closed** to traffic. Normal Sunday road closures in Golden Gate Park will be in effect with automobile access along JFK Drive restricted from Stanyan Street to Transverse Drive.

Increased traffic and limited parking around Music Concourse Drive, Nancy Pelosi Drive, Martin Luther King Drive and Kezar Drive.

A complementary shuttle will be offered within Golden Gate Park at several stops noted on the attached map.

Travel by public transportation, bicycle, and foot are strongly encouraged as parking will be limited.
